Affordable Art Sale 2017

About the Sale:

From 23rd January to 11th February 2017, the gallery will be holding an exhibition for all artists who have work which they would like to clear from their studio. This will be an opportunity for customers either to buy artworks at a lower price than they have previously been exhibited, or to buy experimental or un-shown works at affordable prices.

Artworks which have previously been exhibited should be priced at least a 25% reduction.

Artwork or craftwork in any medium will be considered for display in the exhibition.

Closing date for Entry:

All entry forms must be submitted to the Arts Centre by 4.30pm on Thursday 12th January 2017.

Submission and Selection:

Artists are able to submit a maximum of 2 artworks for wall hanging (*this also applies to 3D works*).

Work in any medium is eligible, however due to space available there will be a restriction on size which will be 80cmX80cm to include the frame.

Preparing artwork for display

Artists should note that this is an Art Sale and NOT a formal exhibition .

All artwork must be for sale.

A luggage-style label showing the artist's name, title of artwork, medium, price must be securely attached to the back of the work.

*All artworks which are to be wall-hung, must have D-rings attached approximately 100mm (4 inches) from the top of the artwork, or proportionally-near the top of small artworks.

DAMAGED FRAMES OR DAMAGED OR WET ARTWORK WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

Fees and Charges:

There is a small submission charge of £5 for 2 wall based pieces or £10 for wall and browser work/cards for entry in to this exhibition and a commission fee of 30% + VAT on all sales will apply.

Cards and "Browser Work"

In addition to the main artworks artists may submit up to 5 pieces of work for display in browsers.

Work for browsers should be suitable presented in a clear cellophane envelope and a label with the exhibitors name, title, medium and price firmly attached to the back.

Cards are welcome – up to 10 per artist, sealed in a cellophane bag with a small label with artist name and price should be fixed to the back.

Delivery and Collection of Artwork

Delivery of artworks to the Arts Centre will be on Saturday 21st January between 1pm and 4pm only.

Collection of unsold work will be on Saturday 11th February between 3.30pm and 4.30pm.

Please ensure you keep your receipt to collect your work.

Sales and payment.

For the "Winter Affordable Art Sale" there will be a charge of 30%+ VAT commission taken on sales.

The calculation for this as prescribed by HMRC is:

Artist Fee	-	£100
Commission at 30%	-	£30
Subtotal	-	£130
VAT* (multiply by 1.2)	-	£26
Selling Price	-	£156

Commissions of artwork and sales of work through gallery introductions.

If you receive a commission of artwork or sell artwork as a result of your customer being introduced to you by the gallery, or by seeing your work displayed in an exhibition at the gallery, we would respectfully ask that you pay a commission to the gallery, equivalent to the percentage commission-charge of that exhibition.

Insurance

N.B: Exhibitors are responsible for insuring their own artwork. Cranleigh Arts Centre cannot be held responsible for damage, loss or theft of any artwork or possessions of the exhibitor. Exhibitions insurance can be obtained at reasonable cost through Artists Network (a-n) at www.a-n.co.uk

Hanging and Display

The team at Cranleigh Arts Centre will be responsible for the hanging and display of all artworks in the exhibition. This will include a rotation of artwork hanging on the wall to ensure that all artists and works are afforded the best possible opportunity to have their work displayed in a prominent position. Any work not on the wall and not suitable for display in a browser will be stacked against the wall for public perusal.

Note: While we will endeavour to hang as much work as possible, Cranleigh Arts Centre cannot guarantee that every artwork will be hung on the wall.

There will be no preview for the "Winter Affordable Art Sale".

Cranleigh Arts Centre will advertise the exhibition in as many ways as possible.
